No. M-6/JE(SS)/2010/8156 .- The following draft of the rules further to amend the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Rules, 1965, in its application to the State of Haryana, which the Governor of Haryana proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) read with sub-section (2) of section 25 of the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1963 (Punjab Act No. 41 of 1963), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 25 for the information of persons likely to be affected thereby.

Notice is hereby given to the draft of rules will be taken into consideration by the Government on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days of the publication of this notification in the Official Gazette, together with the objections or suggestions, if any, which may be received in writing by the Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Government, Haryana, Town and Country Planning Department, Chandigarh, from any person with respect to the draft of the rules, before the expiry of the period specified:-

Draft Rules

1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development (Haryana Amendment) Rules, 2010.
(2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.
2. In the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Rules, 1965, for the proviso to rule 26-F, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely: -

“Provided that if the owner makes an application in writing for further renewal of the change of land use permissions and if the Director is satisfied that the delay in execution of works was for reasons beyond the control of the applicant, such permission may be further renewed maximum upto a period of one year on payment of 10% of conversion charges applicable as on date in the form of a demand draft in favour of the Director.”.
