**Subject: Policy regarding setting up of Warehouses in Agriculture Zone.**

Ref. In continuation to this office memo no Misc-199/7/16/2006-2TCP, dated 16.6.2010.

In order to avoid misuse of the change of land use permission granted for a warehouse to be used for storage of agriculture produce, Governor of Haryana is pleased to impose following additional conditions while considering the permission under the provisions of the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Rules, 1965: -

1. The applicant will furnish an undertaking that if it is found at any stage that the warehouse is being used for storage of non agriculture produce (for which conversation charges are higher), an amount equivalent to double the difference of conversion charges shall be recovered alongwith interest @ 12% per annum (compounded annually) from the date of grant of change of land use permission.
2. Two sureties shall also be submitted alongwith this undertaking.
