No. M-6/JE(B)/2010/ 1447 .- The following draft of the rules further to amend the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Rules, 1965, in its application to the State of Haryana, which the Governor of Haryana proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) read with sub-section (2) of section 25 of the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1963 (Punjab Act No. 41 of 1963), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 25 for the information of persons likely to be affected thereby.

Notice is hereby given to the draft of rules will be taken into consideration by the Government on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days of the publication of this notification in the Official Gazette, together with the objections or suggestions, if any, which may be received in writing by the Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Government, Haryana, Town and Country Planning Department, Chandigarh, from any person with respect to the draft of the rules, before the expiry of the period specified:-

Draft Rules

1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development (Haryana Amendment) Rules, 2010.  
(2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.
2. In the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Rules, 1965, in rule 2,
  - (i) for the sign “.” existing at the end, the sign and word “; and” shall be substituted; and
  - (ii) after clause (h), the following clause shall be added namely:-  
“(i) “title to land” or “title deed” means a document evidencing applicant’s ownership or lease right for such period as may be specified by the Government for different purposes.”.
