Subject: Policy for grant of licenses - Rationalization of levels of decision making with respect to policies to grant licenses.

Ref. In continuation to this office memo No.7/16/2006-2TCP, dated 19.12.2006.

It is informed that Council of Ministers in its meeting held on 16.6.2010 had deliberated the issue of rationalizing the levels of decision making with respect to policies to grant licenses under the provisions of the Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975. The Council of Ministers in its meeting held on 16.6.2010 decided that the Minister-in-Charge, Town and Country Planning Department may only bring the major policy framework cases for consideration of the Council of Ministers keeping in view the provisions of Rules of Business in this regard after obtaining the approval of Chief Minister. Any deviations/relaxation in the already approved policies may be dealt by the Minister-in-Charge with the approval of the Chief Minister, who may consider such relaxations in cases of exceptional circumstances and cases involving extreme hardship, after recording reasons for the same. Further action in this regard is to be taken accordingly.
